**Local Needs:** THE PRIORITY NEEDS OF THE DISTRICT FOR ALL IMPROVEMENT PLANS ARE IN STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT.

- IN 2011, THE DISTRICT MET MISSOURI'S ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REPORT (APR) STANDARDS IN 14 OF 14 CRITERIA, EARNING THE DISTRICT IN PERFORMANCE DESIGNATION FOR THE 3RD CONSECUTIVE YEAR.
- IN TERMS OF NCLB'S AYP, THE DISTRICT MET AYP IN 3 OF 4 GROUPS IN MATHEMATICS INCLUDING DISTRICT TOTAL, WHITE, AND IEP BUT DID NOT MEET AYP IN FREE/REDUCED LUNCH. IN COMMUNICATION ARTS, THE DISTRICT DID NOT MEET AYP ON ANY OF THE 4 GROUPS. THE DISTRICT MET AYP IN ATTENDANCE RATE AT 95.1%--AN INCREASE FROM 94.9% IN 2010.&NBSP; ADDITIONALLY, THE DISTRICT MET AYP IN GRADUATION RATE AT 91.0%, THE SAME AS IN 2010.

- THUS, THE DISTRICT IS MAKING SIGNIFICANT PROGRESS TOWARD AYP GOALS.
- THE DISTRICT IMPROVED THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS SCORING PROFICIENT OR ADVANCED IN 11 OF 15 SUBGROUPS IN COMMUNICATION ARTS.

HS ACT SCORES REMAINED STATIC IN 2011 WITH A COMPOSITE AVERAGE OF 20.6, STILL BELOW THE STATE AVERAGE OF 21. HOWEVER, THE DISTRICT INCREASED THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS TESTING IN 2011 BY 39% AND INCREASED THE PERCENT OF STUDENTS SCORING AT OR ABOVE NATIONAL AVERAGE FROM 28.8% IN 2010 TO 34.6% IN 2011. IN ADDITION, THE DISTRICT SAW SLIGHT INCREASES IN THE ACT ENGLISH AND READING SUBSCORES.
- SUSPENSION RATES FOR BOTH SPECIAL EDUCATION AND REGULAR EDUCATION STUDENTS ARE BELOW STATE AVERAGES AND HAVE DECREASED OVER THE LAST 3 YEARS.
- DISTRICT GRADUATES ENTERING POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION INCREASED SLIGHTLY IN 2011.

**Comments:** IN 2009, THE DISTRICT MET AYP IN CA. IN 2010, THE DISTRICT MET AYP IN 7 OF 14 SUBGROUPS IN CA. THE DISTRICT IMPROVED IN 10 OF 14 SUBGROUPS IN CA. IN 2011, THE DISTRICT MET AYP IN 9 OF 15 SUBGROUPS IN CA. THE DISTRICT IMPROVED IN 11 OF 15 SUBGROUPS IN CA. THE 3-8 SPECIAL EDUCATION SUBGROUP, IN CA, MADE GAINS IN 2010 FROM 19.51% TO 19.59%; HOWEVER THE GAINS WERE NOT SIGNIFICANT IN COMPARISON TO THE DISTRICT'S GAINS IN CA.

1. **Strategy:** A NINTH GRADE COURSE, ACCELERATED LITERACY, IS REQUIRED OF NINTH GRADE STUDENTS WHO ENTER HIGH SCHOOL WITH MEASURABLE DEFICIENCIES IN LITERACY AND STUDY SKILLS. THE COURSE WILL FOCUS ON ACCELERATING THE READING AND STUDY SKILLS OF THE STUDENTS WHO QUALIFY FOR THE COURSE. ACHIEVEMENT DATA AND GPA DATA WILL BE MONITORED TO DETERMINE THE ACADEMIC SUCCESS RATES OF STUDENTS WHO COMPLETE THE ACCELERATED LITERACY COURSE.
