

Education down





#### **Energy Savings as a Financial Mechanism**

- Most school districts have more needs than funds available. Trying to balance where resources go is very difficult and we are always trying to find a way to help your money go further.
- As equipment in facilities age, the cost to maintain that equipment increases. At some point, there it makes more sense to replace than to continue to repair.

### **Project Profile**

#### **PROJECT SCOPE**

#### 1. Building Envelope Improvements

Sealing around window, door, and wall/roof to reduce air infiltration

#### 2. Water Conservation Measures

 Replace older, high gallons per flush valves with higher efficiency flush valves

#### 3. Building Automation System

Update and Improve Building Automation System in every building

#### 4. Retro-commissioning

 Retrocommission all mechanical equipment that is not being replaced in bond issue/energy project

#### 5. Electric to Natural Gas in Middle School

 Upgrade electrical heating coils to hot water coils heated via Natural Gas


#### 6. HVAC Replacements

- HVAC replacements for equipment past it's useful life at:
  - High School
  - Oak Grove Elementary
  - Primary School
  - Early Childhood (modifications to accommodate space update)

#### **PROJECT ENERGY SAVINGS**

- Energy Savings
  - Items 1-5 pay for themselves over a 15 year period AND provide excess savings to help fund item 6
- Excess Savings
  - Current estimates put us about \$500,000 of excess savings that can be used to help pay for \$3,180,000 of the costs of Item 6
     HVAC Replacements.






### How Do We Save Energy?

- The hours the equipment operates






